The program provides wage subsidies to employers from not-for-profit organizations, the public-sector, and private sector organizations with 50 or fewer full-time employees, to create quality summer work experiences for young people aged 15 to 30 years.

What has changed for Canada Summer Jobs in the past few years?

New expanded eligibility now includes all youth aged 15-30, and is no longer restricted to students.

To improve program delivery, 2020 CSJ-funded employers and youth participants will be asked to complete a survey prior to the end of the work placement.
